- We are the third most populous nation in the world behind India and China
- We add roughly 3.3 million people a year (much of it from immigration) or 33 million per decade, nearly 100 million every thirty years
- We are marching toward a population of one billion
- We need to consider expanding population and population policy in the immigration discussion

**Directions from I-5:** Exit Palomar Airport Road and go east 7 miles to Rancho Santa Fe Road. Turn right/south and drive a half mile and take the first left at Lake San Marcos Drive. Turn left on San Marino Drive, turn right on La Bonita Drive. Look for blue sign "Community Recreation Center." The Lake Pavilion Room is on left behind a tall wrought iron fence. Parking is in front of the building. Look for LWV sign.

**Directions from I-15:** Take Highway 78 towards Oceanside, proceed west about four miles, exit and turn left onto San Marcos Blvd., go about two miles, turn left onto Rancho Santa Fe Road. Take first left on Lake San Marcos Drive - follow directions above to the Lake Pavilion Room.
